Position Scope

- Complete on-site installations and commissioning of patient lift systems – training will be provided
- Cut, drill, assemble and install all lift system components as required by Guldmann installation procedures and techniques – training will be provided
- Organize removal of equipment and tools when installation work is complete
- Pivot and adapt to unique installation conditions and environments, think “out of the box” as required with safety as a top priority
- Receiving and organizing materials at customer sites and Guldmann warehouses
- Coordinate installations with Project Coordinator/Manager
- Complete the appropriate documentation upon completion of installation and testing, ensuring all paperwork is submitted in a timely manner – training will be provided
- Work in coordination with the Project Coordinator/ Manager to organize and plan installation trips outside of HRM
- Limited personal interaction with staff and others within facilities must be respectful, professional and courteous

Qualifications

- Background in construction or other building trades
- Exposure to different structure types (concrete, steel, wood, etc.)
- Exposure to ‘Patient Lift systems’ in healthcare facilities would be an asset
- Knowledge and experience in construction, building and hardware installations, electro-mechanical systems and devices
- Troubleshooting and repair of electro-mechanical systems would be an asset
- Ability to read and interpret construction drawings and room layouts
- Mechanical aptitude and the ability to assemble hardware & components
- Must be willing and able to travel throughout Nova Scotia and work overnight at times
- Must possess a valid driver’s license and supply a clean drivers’ abstract
- Liaise with the Project Coordinator/ Manager to advise of daily site progress and work though any issues encountered
